PRAISE GOD

We are thankful to God that Fairmount has no positive cases among our residents other than those patients admitted from area hospitals recuperating in our Dogwood isolation hallway. We admitted another COVID-19 positive patient from the hospital into Dogwood this week and discharged a patient who recuperated from COVID-19. We have treated 23 patients in the Dogwood isolation hallway since the beginning of April.

UNIVERSAL TESTING

In compliance with a DOH order, COVID-19 testing of Health Care residents and team members were conducted this week. We should have the results next week. Many other retirement communities have seen positive test results of asymptomatic residents and team members through this testing. We anticipate we will also have some of our residents and team members who are not displaying symptoms of the virus to test positive. We have plans in place should that be the case. Testing of Personal Care residents and team members will be conducted on July 30.

MASKS ARE MANDATORY IN PA

As a reminder, Pennsylvania has an order in place requiring the wearing of masks whenever you leave your home. Your mask protects others, so please wear your mask as an act of kindness to others.

Thank you for remaining vigilant and following the protocols from the CDC regarding hand hygiene, wearing face coverings, maintaining safe distancing and avoiding large gatherings of people, especially in enclosed areas. 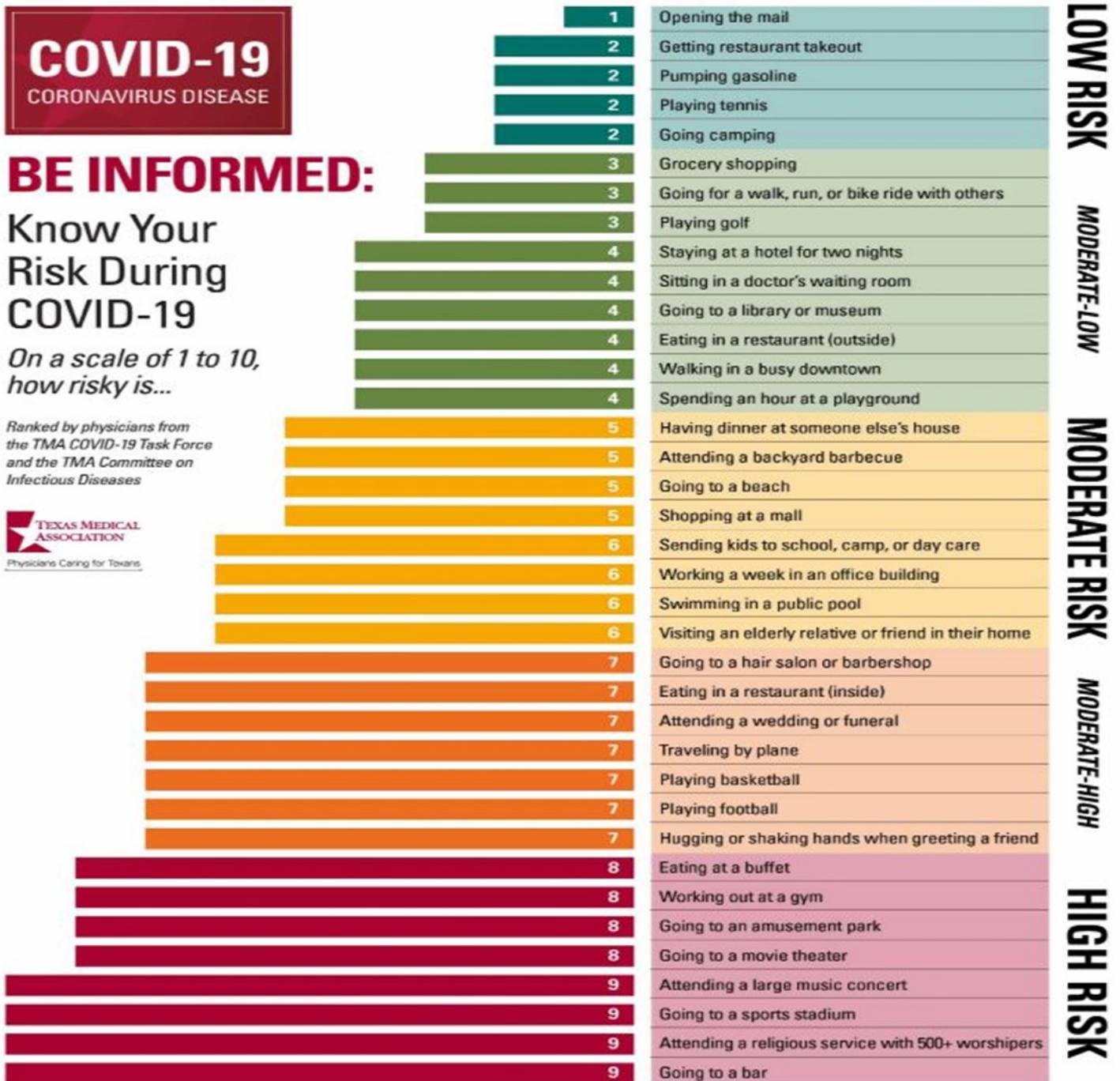
Know Your Risk During COVID-19
