## **FINAL RESULTS OF THE SEVENTH ROUND OF HEALTH CARE UNIVERSAL TESTING**

With thanks to our Heavenly Father, we are pleased to announce that we had no positive COVID-19 test results from our universal Health Care testing administered on September 9, 2020. The results are as follows:

- 213 tested negative
- 0 tested positive

## **FAIRMOUNT CONTINUES TO TEST**

The latest PA Department of Health guidance issued on September 3, 2020, requires that we continue testing based on our county's test positivity rate. According to the most recent positivity rate in Lancaster County, we are required to test weekly our direct care team members and only those residents with contact outside of Fairmount. On September 16, we tested over 100 team members and health care residents. The results are still pending.

## **PERSONAL CARE TO ENTER PHASE 3 OF REOPENING**

Wheat Ridge Personal Care and Farm Crest Personal Care will be moving into Phase 3 of reopening on September 22. In Phase 3, Personal Care residents will be permitted to visit the Beauty Salon for appointments and go on monthly bus trips in small groups, spaced safely apart.

## **RESIDENTIAL LIVING BUS TRIPS RESUMING**

Bus trips to grocery stores will resume for Residential Living residents soon. The bus will be limited to five passengers, spaced safely apart, along with the bus driver. More information will be forthcoming.

## **HEALTH CARE & PERSONAL CARE VIRTUAL FAMILY MEETING**

Fairmount will hold a virtual family meeting for the families of our Health Care and Personal Care residents on the evening of September 22. This will be a time for loved ones to connect and ask questions of Fairmount's leadership team.
