THIS WEEK'S COVID-19 TESTING

COVID-19 testing of residents and team members was conducted in Health Care, Wheat Ridge Personal Care and Farm Crest Personal Care on October 28. The results are pending.

We will hold another round of testing in Health Care and Wheat Ridge Personal Care on November 3. This week's results will determine if testing will be required in Farm Crest Personal Care next week.

We were notified this week that a team member tested positive. That team member last worked on October 24 and is quarantining at home.

Lancaster County's COVID-19 positivity rate rose above 5% this week requiring that we continue to test weekly in Health Care until the rate goes below 5%.

FLU VACCINES

DOGWOOD HALLWAY ADMISSION

We had three admissions into our Dogwood isolation hallway and two Dogwood residents discharge this week. We have cared for a total of 74 individuals in Dogwood since early April.
