COVID-19 TESTING

Residents in Health Care and Personal Care and Fairmount team members tested for COVID-19 on January 14 and 15. The results were as follows:

- 205 negative results
- 6 positive results

The positive results came from two direct care team members who are quarantining at home before returning to work. Two Farm Crest Personal Care residents and two Wheat Ridge Personal Care residents tested positive and are quarantining in their rooms. No Health Care residents tested positive.

Results from January 18 and 19 testing of Health Care and Personal Care residents and Fairmount team members yielded:

- 186 negative results
- 0 positive results

Another round of testing was conducted on January 21 and 22. The results are pending.

HEALTH CARE, PERSONAL CARE & FAIRMOUNT STAFF COVID-19 VACCINATIONS

CVS staff provided COVID-19 vaccinations to Farm Crest Personal Care residents today. CVS will return tomorrow, Saturday, January 23, to administer the second round of COVID-19 vaccinations for residents in Health Care and Fairmount team members and will also provide the first dose to those Health Care residents and team members who did not already receive their first dose. Personal Care residents will receive their second dose of the vaccine on February 12 and 13. It is highly recommended that you receive the vaccine to protect you and your loved ones.

The only side effects experienced were those similar to the normal side effects which occur with the flu shot or any other vaccines.

RESIDENTIAL LIVING COVID-19 VACCINATIONS

Stauffer's Pharmacy will be administering vaccinations for our Residential Living residents. Nearly 70% of our apartment and cottage residents have signed up to receive the vaccination to protect their health and the wellbeing of their friends and families. Once we have determined the amount of the vaccine required, Stauffer's will place an order with the state and set a date when the vaccinations will be administered.

DOGWOOD HALLWAY UPDATE

There were two admissions into the Dogwood dedicated COVID care center this week and four discharges. To date, we have cared for 116 individuals in Dogwood since early April.
