We are thankful that no residents tested positive for COVID-19 this week. However, one team member tested positive and will isolate at home before returning to work. Due to the positive test result, Mountain View (second floor) of our Health Care center is closed to visitors until we have two full weeks without any new positive cases. Visitation for Valley View (first floor) in Health Care and Personal Care continues with normal visitation hours:

- Monday through Friday from 9:30 am to 11:30 am and 1 pm to 4 pm
- Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 5:30 pm to 7 pm
- Saturday and Sunday from 1 pm to 4 pm

Each visitor will be screened by having their temperature taken and must answer potential COVID symptoms or exposure questions prior to receiving a visitor sticker which must be worn while visiting. Masks are also required while visiting. Thank you for keeping our residents and team members safe! A positive case among our residents or team members will affect our visitation policies.

CHANGES TO CDC GUIDANCE

In response to the latest guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) related to the relaxation of certain safety precautions to prevent the spread of COVID-19, fully vaccinated Fairmount Residential Living residents are no longer required to wear a mask while in common areas of the apartment buildings. The CDC guidance does not pertain to our supportive living areas. All visitors, including fully vaccinated Residential Living residents, are still required to wear a mask when entering our Wheat Ridge Building, Cats Back Café, the Chapel, the Health Care center and the Personal Care neighborhoods at Wheat Ridge and Farm Crest.
