## **VACCINATION OPPORTUNITIES**

- Fairmount will be hosting a COVID vaccination clinic on May 27. Anyone interested in getting a Moderna or Johnson & Johnson vaccine that day should contact the receptionist at 717-354-1800.
- WellSpan Ephrata Community Hospital is offering free walk-in COVID vaccination clinics on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays from 12 noon to 3 pm. - Saturday and Sunday from 1 pm to 4 pm
