



FAIRMOUNT COVID-19 PREVENTION AND PROTECTION UPDATE

We are thankful that no Health Care or Personal Care residents have tested positive for COVID-19 since January. Additionally, no team members have tested positive in recent weeks. We do, however, have two symptomatic team members with test results pending. Two Residential Living residents tested positive this week and are isolating in their residence until the CDC recommended quarantine time expires.

The positive Residential Living residents' results do not affect visitation for Valley View and Mountain View in Health Care or for Personal Care. Visitation in those areas continues with normal visitation hours:

- Monday through Friday from 9:30 am to 11:30 am and 1 pm to 4 pm
- Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 5:30 pm to 7 pm
- Saturday and Sunday from 1 pm to 4 pm

Visitors will first be screened by having their temperatures taken and providing answers about potential COVID symptoms or exposure. They will then receive a visitor sticker which must be worn while visiting. Masks are also required while visiting. Thank you for keeping our residents and team members safe! A positive case among our residents or team members will affect our visitation policies.

Because the Wheat Ridge Building lobby, Cats Back Café, Beauty Shop, Chapel, Health Care neighborhoods and Personal Care fall under supportive living regulations, all visitors, including fully-vaccinated Residential Living residents, are still required to wear a mask when entering those areas.

Fully-vaccinated Residential Living residents may go “maskless” in indoor and outdoor spaces on the Fairmount campus, other than those areas noted in the preceding paragraph. Unvaccinated Residential Living residents are still required to wear masks in all indoor spaces and when they are outside within six feet of others.

VACCINATION OPPORTUNITIES

More and more of our team members and residents continue to receive the COVID-19 vaccine. If you are interested in receiving the vaccine, there are opportunities available to you.

- WellSpan Ephrata Community Hospital is offering free walk-in COVID vaccination clinics on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays from 12 noon to 3 pm.
