We continue to experience no new positive test results among our Health Care and Personal Care residents and our team members. We did, however, learn that three Residential Living residents tested positive this week. Two have finished quarantining and one is quarantining at home. A fourth Residential Living resident has a COVID-19 test pending.

In-person, in-room visitation remains unchanged for Health Care Mountain View (second floor), Valley View (first floor), Rehab, Wheat Ridge Personal Care and Farm Crest Personal Care neighborhoods.

Regular visiting hours:

- Monday to Friday – 9:30 am to 11:30 am, 1:00 pm to 4:00pm
- Monday, Wednesday, and Friday – 5:30 pm to 7:00 pm
- Saturday and Sunday – 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm

Whether visiting indoors or outdoors, please screen in first at the front lobby. Use hand sanitizer before and after your visit and always wear your mask covering your mouth and nose, for both indoor and outdoor visits. Maintain a safe six-foot distance during your visit and postpone your visit if you are not feeling well.
