



# FAIRMOUNT COVID-19 PREVENTION AND PROTECTION UPDATE

August 6, 2021

Fairmount conducted COVID testing of team members and Health Care and Wheat Ridge Personal Care residents on July 30 and again on August 4 and 5. All residents and team members have tested negative! Visits may resume for residents on first floor of Wheat Ridge Health Care on Friday, August 6. However, Wheat Ridge Personal Care will remain closed to visitors at this time.

The following measures are to be followed when visiting in order to keep you, our residents, and team members safe:

- Screening of all who enter the building, whether taking the resident on an outing or visiting, for temperature check, signs and symptoms of COVID or close contact with someone with COVID infection in the prior 14 days (regardless of vaccination status). You will be denied entry if you have an elevated temperature or answer yes to the questions.;
- Outdoor visits are preferable;
- Masks covering your nose and mouth must be worn at all times during the visit (indoors or outdoors);
- Use hand sanitizer when you enter the building;
- Maintain a 6-foot distance from others;
- Postpone or reschedule your visit if you have not been feeling well.
- Regular visiting hours:
  - Monday – Friday - 9:30 am – 11:30 am, 1:00 pm – 4:00pm
  - Monday, Wednesday, and Friday evenings – 5:30 pm – 7:00 pm
  - Saturday and Sundays – 1:00 – 4:00 pm

It is imperative to continue to practice safe measures—getting vaccinated, wearing your mask in public, frequently washing your hands, and avoiding large group activities, especially indoor. More cases of the Delta variant of COVID are showing up across Lancaster County and the region.

## **RSV CASES IN MOUNTAIN VIEW**

This week, we experienced several additional cases of respiratory syncytial virus, or RSV, among our Mountain View (second floor) Health Care residents. RSV is a common virus that affects the lungs and breathing passages. Visitation to our Mountain View neighborhood residents remain suspended at this time.
