## **VALLEY VIEW & REHAB VISITATION SUSPENDED**

Visitation to Valley View and Rehab will remain suspended until September 10, assuming we have no additional positive results with our continued testing.

Due to the positive team member and potential exposure to our residents, visitation to Mountain View (second floor of Health Care), Valley View, Rehab and Wheat Ridge Personal Care was suspended as a precaution. All team members and residents were tested multiple times this week. No additional team members or residents tested positive.

## **VACCINATION HELPS PREVENT COVID & REDUCES SEVERITY OF SYMPTOMS**

WellSpan reported this week that they currently have 127 COVID patients in their hospitals, 117 of them are unvaccinated. 22 of the 23 COVID patients in the ICU are unvaccinated. 15 of the 16 COVID patients on ventilators are unvaccinated.
