NEW COVID POSTIVE CASES

Team Members: 6 Health Care Residents: 9 Personal Care Residents: 0 Residential Living: 2

VISITATION CLOSED HEALTH CARE & REHAB

Visitation to Valley View and Mountain View in Health Care, and Cedar and Dogwood Hallways in Rehab is suspended at the present time.

This week, six additional team members tested positive for COVID and are quarantining.

In Health Care, we are currently treating 19 COVID positive Health Care residents in the Aspen and Birch Hallways in Valley View (first floor of Health Care excluding Rehab). All active COVID + residents were moved to these hallways to prevent infection to other residents. Staff in those hallways will be dedicated to those areas exclusively to avoid further transmission. Infection prevention measures are reviewed daily with our team members.

Two Residential Living residents tested positive for COVID since our last communication.

Testing will continue two times per week for all team members and residents until we have two weeks of testing with no new positive cases.
