VISITATION CLOSED HEALTH CARE & REHAB

Visitation to Valley View and Mountain View in Health Care, and Cedar and Dogwood Hallways in Rehab is suspended at the present time.

We are thankful that we had no new COVID positive cases among our residents this week. However, we did have two team members test positive. They will quarantine before returning to Fairmount. We will continue to test two times per week until we have two weeks without any new positive cases.

Sadly, two Health Care residents passed away due to complications related to COVID this week.

DOGWOOD COVID ADMISSIONS

We are anticipating within the next week to open the entire Dogwood Hallway to admit COVID positive patients from area hospitals and personal care facilities. In February, we reduced the number of rooms accepting COVID positive patients from seven to one in Dogwood. Cedar Hallway in Rehab will become a yellow zone, meaning it will be dedicated to admitting rehab patients who are not COVID positive, but are under observation as they may have been exposed or are not vaccinated.
