CMS ANNOUNCES MANDATORY VACCINATION FOR HEALTH CARE WORKERS

Yesterday, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services announced that the Biden administration is requiring COVID-19 vaccination for all employees in health care facilities that participate in Medi-

care and Medicaid (e.g., nursing homes, hospitals, home health, etc.). According to the mandate, the first dose of the vaccination must be received by December 5, 2021. The second dose (or first dose of Johnson and Johnson) must be received by January 4, 2022. The regulation provides for exemptions based on medical conditions or religious beliefs, observations or practices. Over the next few days, we plan to create vaccination policies and procedures, as well as exemption applications. While there are many different beliefs on this topic, Fairmount needs to abide by the law. Please continue to ask for God's wisdom and His guidance as we navigate our way through this process.
