



FAIRMOUNT COVID-19 PREVENTION AND PROTECTION UPDATE

November 19, 2021

This week we experienced no new COVID positive tests among our residents in Health Care. However, we did experience the following new positive cases:

- One resident in Wheat Ridge Personal Care.
- Four additional residents in Farm Crest Personal Care.
- Five team members, who will quarantine at home before returning to Fairmount, tested positive.
- We learned that two Residential Living residents tested positive.

VISITATION INFORMATION

On November 12, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) released updated guidelines for visitation for senior living communities. Fairmount has revised our visitation guidelines in accordance with these CMS requirements. These changes include expanded visitation hours and less stringent visitation restrictions when there are COVID positive cases among our team members or residents. The new guidelines are available in the entryway of the Wheat Ridge Administration entrance.
