HEMLOCK HALLWAY

The only two active COVID positive residents are on Hemlock hallway on Mountain View (second floor of Health Care). Be careful when visiting in that hallway.

Testing of all Health Care team members and residents, vaccinated and unvaccinated, will continue weekly. Personal Care residents will test only if they are symptomatic.

VISITATION INFORMATION

If you are feeling well, you may continue to visit with residents. Please follow the **infection prevention guidelines** available at the entryway. Please be aware that by visiting you could potentially be exposed or expose others to COVID-19. Additional Personal Protective Equipment (PPE), such as gowns, goggles and gloves, may be required in certain neighborhoods while visiting.

VACCINATION OPPORTUNITIES
