There are no known active COVID positive residents in:

There are active COVID positive residents in Health Care.

Testing of Fairmount team members who are not up-to-date with their vaccinations/boosters continue weekly. Residents in Health Care and Personal Care test only if they are symptomatic or if another resident or team member in their neighborhood tests positive.

Residential Living residents should refrain from attending group activities if you are feeling under-the-weather or are displaying cold-like symptoms.

VISITATION INFORMATION

Visitation in Health Care & Personal Care remains open. If you are feeling well, you may visit with residents. Please follow the **infection prevention guidelines** available at the main administration entryway.

The preferred visitation times are 10am to 7pm daily.
