

FAIRMOUNT COVID-19 PREVENTION AND PROTECTION UPDATE

August 26, 2022

Since August 11, we have experienced additional COVID cases throughout our community.

RESIDENTS:

- <u>Health Care</u>: No residents tested positive
- Rehab: No residents tested positive.
- Wheat Ridge Personal Care: No residents tested positive.
- <u>Farm Crest Personal Care</u>: No residents tested positive.
- Farm Crest Residential Suites: No residents tested positive.
- Residential Living: Six known positive residents and one suspected with COVID. These residents are currently quarantining

TEAM MEMBERS:

• Ten team members tested positive. These team members have either completed their quarantine or are currently quarantining.

Testing of Fairmount team members not up to date with their vaccinations/boosters continue weekly. Residents in Health Care and Personal Care will test only if they are symptomatic or if a resident or team member tests positive.

There are a number of Residential Living who have tested positive recently. Please refrain from attending group activities if you are feeling under-the-weather or are displaying cold-like symptoms.

VISITATION INFORMATION

If you are feeling well, you may continue to visit with residents in Health Care and Personal Care. Please follow the **infection prevention guidelines** available at the main administration entryway.

The preferred visitation times are 10am to 7pm, daily.

VACCINATION OPPORTUNITIES

Obtaining the vaccine and, if you have the vaccine, getting the booster is highly recommended. Anyone who would like to obtain the vaccine or the booster, can register for one of Fairmount's vaccine clinics:

- September 13, 2022, in the Chapel from 2pm to 2:30pm (flu shots, as well)
- October 11, 2002, in the Chapel from 2pm to 2:30pm (flu shots, as well)
