

FAIRMOUNT COVID-19 PREVENTION AND PROTECTION UPDATE

September 23, 2022

Since August 26, we have experienced additional COVID cases throughout our community.

RESIDENTS:

- Health Care: No residents tested positive
- Rehab: No residents tested positive.
- <u>Wheat Ridge Personal Care</u>: 12 residents tested positive. All residents have completed their quarantine.
- <u>Farm Crest Personal Care</u>: No residents tested positive.
- <u>Farm Crest Residential Suites</u>: No residents tested positive.
- <u>Residential Living</u>: One known positive resident. This resident completed their quarantine.

TEAM MEMBERS:

• 13 team members have tested positive. These team members have either completed their quarantine or are currently quarantining.

Testing of Fairmount team members not up to date with their vaccinations/boosters continue weekly. Residents in Health Care and Personal Care will test only if they are symptomatic or if a resident or team member tests positive.

VISITATION INFORMATION

If you are feeling well, you may continue to visit with residents in Health Care and Personal Care. Please follow the **infection prevention guidelines** available at the main administration entryway.

The preferred visitation times are 10am to 7pm, daily.

VACCINATION OPPORTUNITIES
